

HURRICANE IDALIA



- MADE LANDFALL ON THE MORNING OF AUGUST 30, 2023 NEAR KEATON BEACH
- CATEGORY 3 WITH SUSTAINED WINDS OF 125 MPH
- FIRST MAJOR LANDFALLING HURRICANE IN THIS PORTION OF FLORIDA
- DEVASTATING STORM SURGE ALONG FLORIDA COAST (7-12 FEET)
- HURRICANE FORCE GUSTS FELT AS FAR INLAND AS LOWNDES COUNTY, GA (80 MILES)
- OVER 7 INCHES OF RAIN IN ROUGHLY 16 HOUR SPAN

RESPONSE TIMELINE

- PARTNER BRIEFINGS BEGAN AUGUST 24TH
- EOC BRIEFINGS WITH PARTNERS AND NWS BEGAN ON AUGUST 28TH
- EOC WAS ACTIVATED AT 0500 ON AUGUST 30TH
- 45 PERSONNEL REPRESENTING 20 DIFFERENT AGENCIES STAFFED EOC
- EOC STOOD DOWN AT MIDNIGHT AND REOPENED AT 0600 ON AUGUST 31ST (OPERATIONAL PERIOD WAS 0600 2000 EACH DAY)
- CALL CENTER ESTABLISHED AUGUST 31ST
- GA VOAD REPRESENTATIVE STAFFED EOC BEGINNING ON SEPTEMBER 1ST
- POINTS OF DISTRIBUTION SET UP ON SEPTEMBER 1ST
- DEBRIS REMOVAL CONTRACTORS BEGAN WORK SEPTEMBER 4TH

STORM IMPACTS

- 80-95 % POWER OUTAGES ALONG THE PATH OF THE EYE
- COUNTIES WEST OF THE EYE SAW 40-60 PERCENT OUTAGES
- IN LOWNDES COUNTY
 - CLOSE TO 1,200 HOMES DAMAGED WITH 900 EITHER MAJOR OR DESTROYED
 - ESTIMATED 1.5 MILLION CUBIC YARDS OF VEGETATIVE DEBRIS
 - PROVIDED SHELTER FOR 78 INDIVIDUALS
 - PA COSTS CURRENTLY ESTIMATED AT \$25 MILLION COUNTYWIDE
 - VERIZON ONLY HAD 1 CELL TOWER STILL IN OPERATION
 - 911 CALL VOLUME INCREASED BY OVER 3,000%

BIGGEST CHALLENGES

- LACK OF BACKUP COMMUNICATIONS
- NO INITIAL COORDINATION WITH OUTSIDE GROUPS
- WILLINGNESS TO NOTIFY EOC OF PRESENCE & AVAILABLE RESOURCES
- MANY OF THE PRE-IDENTIFIED RECOVERY LOCATIONS WERE UNAVAILABLE/INACCESSIBLE
- COMMUNITY OFFICIALS UNFAMILIAR WITH PLANS
- FUNDING FOR RECOVERY

LESSONS LEARNED (KEYS TO SUCCESS)

- IMPORTANCE OF ESTABLISHED RELATIONSHIPS
- GETTING EVERYONE TO THE TABLE
- NEED TO BE FLEXIBLE
- DOCUMENTING "SOFT MATCH"
- COLLABORATION BETWEEN GOVERNMENT & NON-GOVERNMENT
